# DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

**1**

## Arrival Welcome & Briefing 0km

Welcome to Cape Town! Your journey begins with a warm airport greeting and transfer to the iconic V&A Waterfront. Spend the day discovering the vibrant “Mother City,” then meet your tour group for a welcome drink, trip briefing, and dinner at one of Cape Town’s top restaurants.

## EXPLORE CAPE TOWN 0km

After breakfast, start your adventure by receiving your motorcycle and go on a scenic ride through Cape Town to get comfortable on your bike. Enjoy a leisurely lunch at one of the Cape’s renowned wine estates, then wind down with a delicious dinner at a vibrant Waterfront restaurant. This is just the beginning!

## Cape Town → Arniston 20% off-road 360km

Venture inland through a breathtaking mountain pass. Step back in time at a quaint coffee shop in the desert. Then ride down the mountains once more, follow a dusty trail along a river, and end on the rocks in a picturesque sea-side village. End the day with a sun-downer and a well-earned, authentic South African “braai” (barbeque).

## Arniston → Jongensfontein 60% off-road 150km

Venture inland through a breathtaking mountain pass. Step back in time at a quaint coffee shop in the desert. Then ride down the mountains once more, follow a dusty trail along a river, and end on the rocks in a picturesque sea-side village. End the day with a sun-downer and a well-earned, authentic South African “braai” (barbeque).

## Jongensfontein → Oudtshoorn 10% off-road 150km

Day four brings something truly unforgettable—a walk in the wild with majestic elephants! After a short ride, meet these gentle giants up close in an experience that will stay with you forever. Then it’s back into the mountains, where we settle in for two nights on a beautifully preserved historic farm. Pure magic!

## Oudtshoorn – Rest day with OSTRICHES AND CAVES 20km

Only 20kms to ride on Day 6, because it’s a rest day—but only for the bikes! Get up close with Africa’s iconic ostriches on a fascinating farm visit, followed by a hearty lunch. Then, journey deep into ancient caves, millions of years old, for an unforgettable underground adventure. Rest day? More like thrill day!

**Oudtshoorn to Prince Albert**  
**40% off-road** **260km**

Today, you'll view history, make history, and live it! Start with a visit to a museum, and after a seafood lunch, conquer South Africa's longest accessible gravel mountain pass. Your journey ends in a charming historic town, where you'll spend the night in a hotel dating back to 1864.

**Prince Albert → Sanbona Private Game Reserve**  
**40% off-road** **260km**

Ride South Africa's most scenic gravel mountain passes and step back in time for a colonial-style lunch, then cruise a thrilling stretch of tar to your luxury safari escape where wildlife, fine wine, and elegant dining await.

**Sanbona Private Game Reserve → Cederberg** **40% off-road**  
**300km**

Ride deep into the Western Cape's shifting mountain landscapes, where fynbos stretches endlessly and every turn reveals new beauty, navigating dirt roads to a magical, nostalgic setting under the stars. Camp in comfort, and wake ready for epic outrides.

**OUTRIDE**

**0km**

Today's optional ride takes you to Wuppertal's historic village and shoe factory, along scenic Cederberg gravel trails to waterfalls and ancient San rock art caves, before returning to the Oasis for lunch, a home-cooked dinner under the stars, and time to unwind before heading back to the Mother City tomorrow.

**11**

**Cederberg → Cape Town**  
**20% off-road** **315km**

As our tour draws to a close, the ride back to Cape Town is filled with nostalgia, memories, and the curves of the Western Cape. Enjoy lunch at a charming local spot before re-entering the buzz of the city. Back at your hotel, freshen up before celebrating the journey with a farewell dinner in one of the Mother City's finest restaurants.

After breakfast, you'll be taken to a special venue for the perfect farewell to Cape Town—one last unforgettable moment. # TRAVEL INFORMATION

South Africa's Western Cape offers a diverse, adventure-filled motorcycle tour with dramatic coastlines, mountain passes, wildlife encounters, vibrant cities, scenic tar and gravel roads, cultural experiences, luxury safari stays, and a welcoming, English-speaking local population.



## PASSPORTS

Passport must be valid for the duration of stay (recommended minimum 6 months validity).



## VISAS

Depending on your nationality, a visa may be required; check current South African regulations before travel.



## FLIGHTS & TRANSFERS

South Africa has well-connected international airports, and transfers are arranged by private car or shuttle.



## LUGGAGE

Standard airline luggage allowances apply, and sturdy packing is recommended for mixed road and safari adventures.



## HEALTH

Vaccinations and malaria precautions may be recommended depending on your destinations; travel insurance is advised.



## PAYMENT

A 30% deposit is required upon reservation. Full payment is due 90 days prior to arrival.



## MONEY

The South African Rand (ZAR) is the local currency; ATMs are common in cities but limited in remote regions.



## LOCAL CULTURE

South Africans are known for their friendliness and relaxed approach to life, with diverse languages and traditions to explore.



## CLIMATE

South Africa offers mostly warm, dry, and sunny conditions, spring blooms into early summer, bringing comfortable temperatures and excellent visibility, with only occasional regional rainfall.



## MOTORBIKES

We include Triumph tiger 900 Rally as a base bike and an upgrade Triumph tiger 1200 Rally.



## FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

From gourmet restaurants to luxury lodges and safari camps, South Africa has diverse food and accommodation options.



## LICENSE

A valid international Motorcycle driver's license or local license is required for driving or riding a motorcycle.



## INSURANCE

Travel insurance is strongly recommended, especially for adventurous activities and long-distance rides.

Road conditions range from smooth tar to challenging gravel passes, requiring moderate riding experience for some routes. (ask us about SA off-road course)
