# DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

## Welcome Dinner

0km

Your journey begins with a warm welcome at Antalya's airport, followed by a smooth transfer to your hotel. In the evening, gather for a briefing about the tour, an introduction to the itinerary, and a motorcycle handover to gear up for the days ahead.

## Ride to Eğirdir

230km

Start your ride by visiting the ancient city of Perge, a bustling Roman city known for its remarkably preserved ruins. Next, head to Sagalassos, a nested archaeological site in the Taurus Mountains. Enjoy scenic village roads as you immerse yourself in unspoiled nature.

## Ride to Beyşehir

270km

Ride to Beyşehir Lake, Turkey's largest freshwater lake, and explore the historic Eşrefoğlu Mosque, a stunning example of Seljuk architecture. Continue your journey to Konya to visit the Mevlana Museum, the final resting place of Rumi, the revered Sufi mystic and poet.

## Ancient Settlements & Silk Road Heritage

220km

Embark on a journey back in time at Çatalhöyük, one of the world's oldest settlements, featuring remarkable Neolithic murals and artifacts. Visit the Sultanhanı Caravanserai, an iconic Seljuk structure that once sheltered Silk Road travelers. End your day with a peaceful overnight stay in Aksaray.

## Valleys, Underground Wonders & Cappadocia

180km

Explore the stunning Ihlara Valley with its ancient rock-carved churches, visit Monastery Valley in Güzelyurt, and discover the remarkable Derinkuyu Underground City. End the day in Cappadocia with an overnight stay in a charming cave hotel.

## Cappadocia Exploration

0km

Start the day with an optional hot air balloon ride over Cappadocia's surreal landscape. Explore the Göreme Open-Air Museum, Uçhisar Castle, and Avanos pottery workshops, then unwind with local dining in the evening.

**7****Journey to Çiftehan 250km**

Carve your way through the winding roads of the majestic Taurus Mountains, where every curve reveals breathtaking views and rugged beauty. After a day of thrilling rides and mountain air, unwind in a tranquil thermal hotel – the perfect blend of adventure and relaxation.

**8****Ride the Taurus: 240km  
From Çiftehan to the Coast**

Descend from the Taurus Mountains to the sparkling Mediterranean coast, enjoying winding roads and breathtaking coastal views. Feel the warmth and sea breeze as you cruise along the shoreline at sunset, ending the day with a delightful sea-view dinner.

**9****A ride through ancient  
mythology 260km**

Begin the day exploring the legendary Heaven & Hell Caves – an awe-inspiring natural wonder steeped in mythology. Afterward, hit the road for a thrilling, twisty mountain ride through dramatic landscapes on the way to Karaman. The journey blends adventure, history in one unforgettable day.

Coast 330km**

Final riding day – return to Antalya through winding mountain roads with a refreshing stop at a scenic waterfall. Feel the thrill of the last ride as you descend toward the coast, ending the adventure with a relaxed farewell dinner by the sea. A perfect finish to an unforgettable journey.

# TRAVEL INFORMATION

Turkey offers a unique blend of history, culture, and natural beauty. Travelers can explore ancient ruins, vibrant towns, and scenic landscapes while enjoying smooth, well-maintained roads ideal for touring.



## PASSPORTS

Passport must be valid for the duration of stay (recommended minimum 6 months validity).



## VISAS

Most travelers can enter Turkey visa-free or with a simple online e-Visa for short stays.



## FLIGHTS & TRANSFERS

Turkey has a very well-connected international airports, and transfers are arranged by private cars or shuttle.



## LUGGAGE

Standard airline luggage allowances apply, and sturdy packing is recommended for mixed road and safari adventures.



## HEALTH

Stay up to date on routine vaccines, bring medications, stay hydrated, and havetravel insurance.



## PAYMENT

A 30% deposit is required upon reservation. Full payment is due 90 days prior to arrival.



## MONEY

Turkey's currency is the Turkish Lira (TRY); credit cards are widely accepted, but carry some cash for markets and small purchases.



## LOCAL CULTURE

Turkey's culture is rich and vibrant, with warm hospitality, long-standing traditions, colorful markets, and welcoming local communities.



## CLIMATE

On our selected dates we'll enjoy pleasant, mild weather, with warm, sunny coastal days and comfortable inland temperatures with cool mornings and evenings.
