DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

1

Welcome Dinner 0km

Arrive in the vibrant capital of Vietnam and feel the pulse of its energy – the hum of scooters, the scent of street food, and the promise of adventure. Meet your guides and fellow riders for a warm greeting dinner and a taste of the journey ahead.

2

Into the Wild, Phu Luong
190km

Leave behind the bustle of Hanoi as the open road calls. Ride through rolling rice paddies, past small villages, and into the emerald valleys of Phu Luong Nature Reserve – a peaceful paradise of terraces, waterfalls, and ethnic Thai villages.

Valley Trails & Tea Hills, Moc Chau
150km

Twist through misty valleys and bamboo forests as you make your way to Moc Chau, a highland plateau famous for its endless tea plantations. The changing scenery and smiling locals make every kilometer a joy to ride.

The Road Less Traveled, Phu Yen
220km

Today's ride offers a true taste of Vietnam's rugged beauty. Follow mountain passes and cross wooden bridges, stopping for coffee in remote villages before descending to the quiet charm of Phu Yen – a town embraced by hills and rivers.

Through The Clouds, Tu Le
150km

Ride through a maze of mountain passes where clouds drift across the road and every turn reveals another jaw-dropping view. Arrive in Tu Le, surrounded by cascading rice terraces and natural hot springs – the perfect reward for a day in the saddle.

Rivers of Serenity, Pa Uon
160km

Follow the tranquil Da River, a ribbon of blue winding between cliffs and jungle-covered hills. The ride to Pa Uon is pure motorcycling bliss – smooth curves, mirror-like waters, and the hum of your engine echoing through the valleys.

Where History Echoes, Dien Bien Phu **120km**

A shorter but unforgettable day as you reach the historic city of Dien Bien Phu, site of one of the most decisive battles in modern history. The route offers relaxed riding through fertile valleys surrounded by timeless landscapes.

Lake Side Dreams, Thac Ba Lake **230km**

Say goodbye to the peaks and cruise down toward the tranquil Thac Ba Lake. The smooth ride and ever-changing scenery make this a day to remember, ending with a peaceful evening by the water.

Climbing to the Clouds, Sin Ho **180km**

Tackle a thrilling ascent into Vietnam's remote northern highlands. Sin Ho, known as the "Roof of the Northwest," welcomes you with crisp air, dramatic peaks, and the sense of being truly off the map.

The Last Stretch, Hanoi **160km**

The final stretch – soak up every turn, every smell, every moment. Ride through small villages and endless rice paddies before rolling back into Hanoi. It's a mix of nostalgia and pride – you've conquered the northern frontier.

The Road to Sa Pa **160km**

Descend through misty valleys and rise again into the legendary mountains of Sa Pa, surrounded by terraced fields and vibrant local markets. This is Vietnam at its most spectacular – both wild and welcoming.

From Asphalt to Ocean, Cat Ba Island (Transfer)

Trade your helmet for sea breeze as you journey to Cat Ba Island, cruising through Ha Long Bay's emerald waters. Limestone karsts rise from the sea like ancient guardians – the perfect backdrop to shift from adventure to relaxation.

Sailing Through Floating Villages and Hidden Bays

(Transfer)

Cruise between towering limestone cliffs and drift through peaceful floating fishing villages where life moves to the rhythm of the tides. Swim in secluded lagoons, relax on untouched beaches, and take in the quiet beauty of Vietnam's island coast – the perfect counterpoint to days on the open road a bustling Old Quarter.

The Journey's End (Transfer)

Cruise back to the mainland and return to Hanoi with the sea wind still in your hair. In the evening, gather with your crew for a farewell dinner – stories, laughter, and that familiar post-ride glow that only bikers understand.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

Turkey offers a unique blend of history, culture, and natural beauty. Travelers can explore ancient ruins, vibrant towns, and scenic landscapes while enjoying smooth, well-maintained roads ideal for touring.



PASSPORTS

Passport must be valid for the duration of stay (recommended minimum 6 months validity).



VISAS

Most travelers can enter Vietnam with a simple online e-Visa for short stays. Ask us for more information.



FLIGHTS & TRANSFERS

Hanoi has a very well-connected international airport, and transfers are arranged by private cars or shuttle.



LUGGAGE

Standard airline luggage allowances apply, and sturdy packing is recommended for mixed road and safari adventures.



HEALTH

Stay up to date on routine vaccines, bring medications, stay hydrated, and have travel insurance.



PAYMENT

A 30% deposit is required upon reservation. Full payment is due 90 days prior to arrival.



MONEY

Vietnam's currency is the Vietnamese Dong (VND); credit cards are accepted in hotels and upscale restaurants, but it's best to carry cash for local markets, small shops, and rural areas.



LOCAL CULTURE

Turkey's culture is rich and vibrant, with warm hospitality, long-standing traditions, colorful markets, and welcoming local communities.



CLIMATE

Expect occasional seasonal showers, especially earlier in the season, balanced by clear periods, lush landscapes, and pleasant mornings and evenings for riding and sightseeing.

FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

LICENSE

A valid international Motorcycle driver's license or local license is required for driving or riding a motorcycle.
